CAIRNS, TOWNSVILLE AND ROCKHAMPTON VEHICLE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

Transit Australia Group (TAG), new parent company of Sunbus has committed over \$15M to fast-track the replacement of 54 buses by 5 – 7 years, in their Cairns, Townsville and Rockhampton networks.

TAG is committed to making significant improvements to these networks and considers the issue of under-performing air-conditioning systems a number one priority.

The manufacturing of these vehicles has commenced at BusTech on the Gold Coast and the rollout will commence from June 2009, with the final vehicle scheduled to be rolled out within twelve months.

Cairns will receive 24 brand new BusTech MDI's, followed by 19 in Townsville then 11 in Rockhampton.

The purchase of these vehicles would not have been possible without the support of Federal and State Government.
